The canine training and methods he learned in the military allowed him to find his true passion for dogs which led him to further his studies and graduate from the renowned Tom Rose School for professional dog trainers in St. Louis. Carlos earned his Professional and Master Trainer degrees after completing a two year extensive training program.
